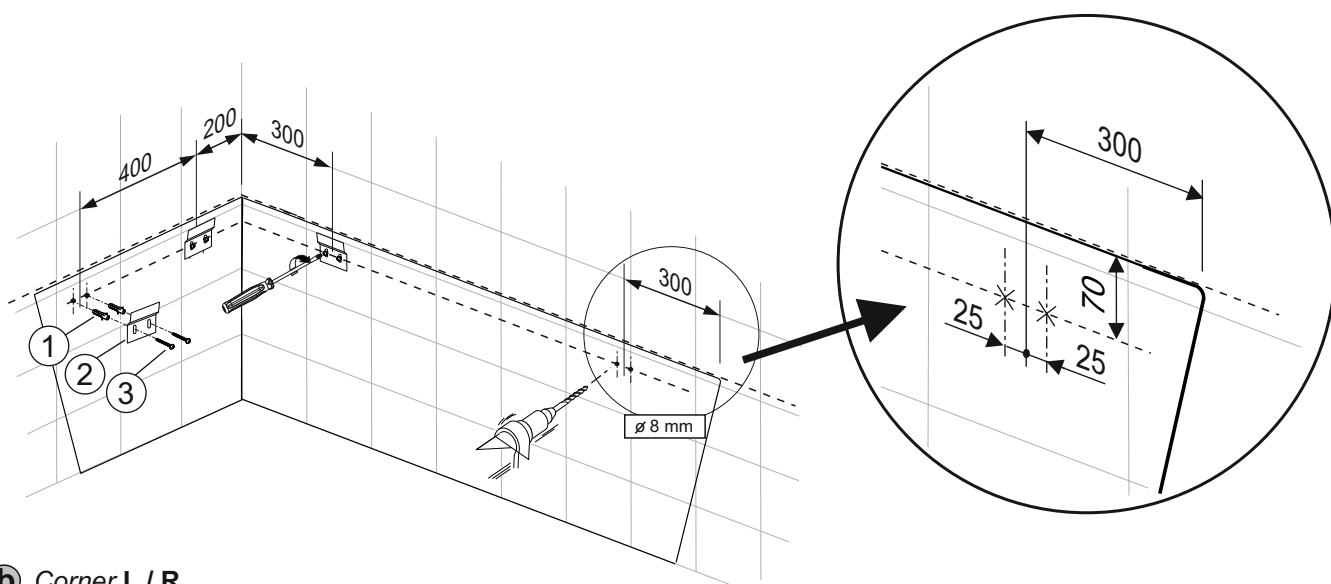


The bathtub must not hang on the wall brackets with its own weight or when full (Fig 7). They are used only for horizontal fixation to prevent movement of the bathtub. It is imperative to place and adjust the bathtub so that it stands firmly on all feet while the tub is aligned before marking the brackets on the wall.
